Victory is a High School

(Recognized by WASC and as a Model School)

- Graduate with a High School Diploma
- Qualify for trade schools & All Junior Colleges
- Qualify for Scholarships Access (\$12,000+ in 2013)
- Office works closely Community Colleges
 - Transition to Sierra College
 - Application process for enrollment and FAFSA

Who attends Victory (debunking the myth)

Most students come for 2 reasons from Rocklin and Whitney:

1) Behind in Credits

- Struggled with Homework
- Struggled with Essential Skills

2) Desire for a smaller school

- Struggled with the Comprehensive School Setting
- Students who wish for a smaller campus

Students expelled do not come to Victory.

Victory Specifics

- Student body size: 80-130
- Individual attention in a small setting:
 - Class Size: 17 students to 1 teacher (Max)
- Very little discipline issues:
 - Small School, Focused students, unique schedule
 - Most Discipline centers around attendance.
- Focus from Staff is not just earning credits:

What it takes to Graduate from VHS


- 200 Credits at VHS (250 at Rocklin)
 - No 3rd year Science, Math, Foreign Language, PE
 - Transferring to Victory can put your “on track” for graduation immediately.
- CREDITS TRANSFER FROM RHS
 - All credit earned at Rocklin counts at VHS
 - PASS YOUR CLASSES
 - Classes passed not needed for VHS count as Elective Credit

Attendance Is Key!

- Time on Task school:
 - 7.5 credits per class per semester (Credit Recovery)
 - Credits are earned through passing & attendance
- Attend Class
 - 95% of work is done “in class”.
 - “Variable Credit” = Immediate Gratification
 - Once you earn your credit , we drop that class
 - Graduate at any point throughout the year

Ways to Obtain Credit at VHS

- Variety of ways to earn credit at VHS:
 - Attend Class
 - Summer School
 - Night School
 - Online Credit Recovery
 - Independent Packet Work
 - ROP

Activities at Victory High School

Students Plans are Individualized

- Every student given a personalized plan that maps their path to graduation.
- Juniors: Goal at end of year is 50 credits left
 - This will allow for 3 morning classes
 - Job opportunities/preparation in afternoons
- Seniors: Goal at end of year is 0 Credits left
 - GRADUATION at Rocklin Event Center
 - Cap/Gown, Board Members/Superintendents, Crowd of 850
