Slide 1 <i>Cover Page</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Include your name and the two careers researched 		
Slide 2 <i>What are your strengths/skills</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Summary of your greatest strengths (from Skills Assessment) • Commentary about your strengths and how they have helped you. 		
Slide 3 <i>What are your areas of growth</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • From analyzing your Naviance/ASVAB results (or from simply self-reflection), what would you consider an area of growth? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ List two ways you could improve in this area 		
Slides 4-5 <i>Description of your first career choice & why you chose it</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A brief description of your profession as a whole • Your specific interest within the profession • Salary, Expected Schedule, Job Outlook, etc. 		
Slides 6-8 <i>Description of your second career choice & why you chose it</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A brief description of your profession as a whole • Your specific interest within the profession • Salary, Expected Schedule, Job Outlook, etc. 		
Slide 9 <i>Overview of your plan of action: Educational Path</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Your Graduation Date • Describe which specific path you will take after graduation: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Community College, Trade School, Internship, Certificate program, 4-Year College program, etc. 		
Slide 10 <i>Overview of your plan of action: Career Path</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Entry Level Job • How to advance within your job from entry level position 		
Slide 11 <i>Personal Goals in Life</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Where you would want to live • Dreams and Goals you have in life other than your career 		
Slide 12 <i>Interview Question Summary</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Using your responses to the interview questions, construct a paragraph (4-7 sentences) explaining who you are as a person and what you stand for. 		
Slide 13 <i>Student Preference</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Portrays information about either or both careers, you as a person, or anything else related to the grad portfolio. 		
Slide 14 <i>Student Preference</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Portrays information about either or both careers, you as a person, or anything else related to the grad portfolio. 		
Slide 15 <i>Questions and Answers</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask for any questions from the audience. • Sufficiently answers the questions when asked, shows an understanding of the grad portfolio 		
Format <i>MLA</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fewer than 25 words per slide • Bullet form only (except for slide #11) • Must use the same font throughout the presentation <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ May vary size, bold, italics, etc. • Must use the same design background throughout the presentation • Graphics, Pictures, and Text must not overlap 		
Presentation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Body Language, Eye contact, and Posture • Inflection, Volume, Enunciation, and Pacing • Does not simply read the PowerPoint, but expands on the bullet points and thoroughly presents the material.
