Announcement to 2018 Graduating Seniors Alfred & Constance Peyrounat Scholarships

- 1. David & Jessica Swanson, along with Jennifer Gamble, are pleased to announce the Alfred & Constance Peyrounat Scholarships, awarded annually to a graduating high school student committed to higher education and requiring financial assistance.
- 2. Each year scholarship(s) will be awarded to support the completion of a 4-year undergraduate college degree. The basis for the award:
 - a. Academic and Extracurricular Achievement
 - b. Community Involvement
 - c. Financial Need
- 3. The funds will be distributed based on the following:
 - a. Attending 4-year college or university:
 - i. The student will receive a quarter of the dollar amount each academic year for a period of four consecutive academic years. For each academic year, the dollar amount will be paid in equal installments in August and January.
 - ii. If the student withdraws from school for a term, the scholarship will be forfeited.
 - b. Attending community college and then transferring to a 4-year college or university:
 - i. While attending community college, the student will receive 10% of the sum each academic year for a period of two consecutive academic years. For each academic year, the 10% will be paid in equal installments at the beginning of each term.
 - ii. Upon transferring to a 4-year college or university, the student will receive 40% each academic year for a period of two consecutive academic years. For each academic year, the 40% will be paid in equal installments at the beginning of each term.
 - iii. If the student withdraws from school for a term, the scholarship will be forfeited.
- 4. Ongoing funding requirements:
 - a. Student must maintain specified academic standards and provide documented evidence each term.
 - b. Deadlines for submittal will be determined based on the educational institution's calendar.
 - c. Requirements for each term:
 - i. Student must maintain a GPA of 2.50 or greater.
 - ii. Student must be a full-time student as defined by the educational institution.
 - iii. Student must provide proof of re-enrollment.
- 5. Number of scholarships may vary each year based on available funds.
- 6. By signing student and parent(s) / guardian(s) agree to the terms outlined in this announcement.
- 7. Scholarships must be claimed directly out of high school. No exceptions.
- 8. Application deadline is **March 31st**. Decisions will be announced in May.
