

**Announcement to 2022 Graduating Seniors
Alfred & Constance Peyrounat Scholarships
Trade/Vocational or Community College**

1. David & Jessica Swanson & Jennifer Gamble are pleased to announce the Alfred & Constance Peyrounat Scholarships, awarded annually to a graduating high school student committed to higher education and requiring financial assistance.
2. Each year scholarship(s) will be awarded to support the completion of certification through an accredited Trade or Vocational School. The basis for the award:
 - a. Academic Achievement
 - b. Financial Need
3. The funds will be distributed based on the following:
 - a. The student will receive funds distributed evenly throughout the duration of their specified program, whether it be terms, quarters, semesters, or specific timeframe modules. For each academic year, the dollar amount will be paid in equal installments in August and January.
 - b. If the student withdraws from school for a term, the scholarship will be forfeited.
4. Ongoing funding requirements:
 - a. Student must maintain specified academic standards and provide documented evidence each term.
 - b. Deadlines for submittal will be January 15th and July 15th of any given year.
 - c. Requirements for Community College each term:
 - i. Student must maintain a GPA of 2.50 or greater.
 - ii. Student must be a full-time student as defined by the educational institution.
 - iii. Student must provide proof of re-enrollment.
 - iv. Student must provide sealed official transcripts.
 - d. Requirements for Trade/Vocational each term:
 - i. Student must be a full-time student as defined by the Trade/Vocational School.
 - ii. Student must provide proof of ongoing enrollment.
 - iii. Student must provide official transcripts or the equivalent as provided by the school.
5. Number of scholarships may vary each year based on available funds.
6. By signing student and parent(s) / guardian(s) agree to the terms outlined in this announcement.
7. Scholarships must be claimed directly out of high school. No exceptions.
8. Application deadline is **April 1st**. Decisions will be announced in May.

3. Essay Questions

All essays must be 500 words, but no more than 1000.

Choose one essay question to complete. *Please indicate which essay question is being answered.*

A. Write your top 10 list.

With this prompt, get creative. Don't simply put 10 things you enjoy — get specific! Pick something you love and give your top 10 — maybe top 10 memories of your life, top 10 favorite books, top 10 quotes, etc. Make sure you give clear explanations of the items on your list as well. The more specific your list is, the better.

B. Tell us a topic that you have changed your mind on in the past three years.

For this essay, don't hesitate to get silly or serious — but make sure you go all the way whichever side you choose! Pick an issue that doesn't come immediately to mind. Try to pinpoint a specific “a-ha” moment your opinion changed, and make sure to give an example of how your changed perspective has influenced your behavior.

C. What book would you recommend to everyone?

Stay away from books that are likely to appear many times. This might go without saying, but make sure it's a book you've already read! Rather than just summarizing the book, explain why you're recommending it.

4. Please list each of your community service activities during high school, identifying your specific role, the time you spend on each activity per month, and how long you have been participating in each activity.

5. Please describe your extracurricular activities and achievements during high school, including any involvement with clubs/organizations, student government, and/or athletics, as well as any paid jobs you have held. For each activity, identify your specific role, the time you spend on each activity per month, and how long you have been participating in each activity.

 - A sealed official copy of your high school transcript.
