Information and Application

What is the Victory High School Ambassador Program?

Student Ambassadors serve as the first point of contact to newly enrolled students at the beginning and throughout the school year. They may also meet and greet community members that come onto campus. The primary goal of the program is to educate and support new students about the programs, resources, and student life at Victory High School.

The Application Process:

- 1) Respond to all questions on the [Victory High School Student Ambassador Application](#) and share it with the Ambassador Coordinator, Mr. Thibideau.
- 2) Go to the staff member you wish to complete the Student Ambassador Recommendation form and ask if they would do you the favor of completing the recommendation form. The forms will be made available to staff members.

After the staff member completes the recommendation, they will forward it to Mr. Thibideau.

The Selection Process:

Applicants are considered for an interview with the selection committee based upon:

- Turning the application in on time
- The thoughtfulness of answers and a well written essay
- Feedback from the staff member on the recommendation form

The most qualified applicants will be invited to an interview. The interview panel will rate each candidate according to:

Confidence

Enthusiasm
Thoughtfulness of answers
Communication skills
Appropriate Attire

Students will be informed, in person, if they have or have not been selected to be a Student Ambassador.

Responsibilities of Victory High School Ambassadors:

- Attend initial training and various team building activities
- Attend monthly group meetings
- Conduct tours of the school and explain various school programs
- Demonstrate leadership and become a role model for other students
- Participate as a trainer for new ambassadors
- Maintain a “C” average or better in all subjects. If grade(s) drop, the student will be asked to meet with an advisor to determine a plan to improve grades. If grades do not improve, the ambassador will not be allowed to continue in the role.
- Abide by the student code of conduct. *If there are behavioral concerns, the administration reserves the right to remove a student from the Ambassador Program.

Ambassador Program Leadership Training:

All training will take place during the school day or after school. No class attendance credit will be lost due to training.

Ambassadors Service Time:

Students will serve for one calendar year. All students must reapply each year. An abbreviated application will be available for Ambassadors wishing to continue in the program.
