

RAEC Standards for Dress

1. Tank tops may be worn as long as they are not low-cut, all undergarments are concealed by straps that are at least 1 inch (2 fingers) thick, and the arm holes do not extend more than 3 inches down the torso. (Racerback Tanks, Bandeaux, Spaghetti straps and/or Cami's are not permitted).
2. Sheer tops may be worn as long as the undershirt fits the above criteria.
3. Pants must be worn at or above the hip point (no sagging) and be able to stay up without a belt.
4. Shorts cannot have holes of any sort placed above the pocket line, even if the hole has fabric behind it, keeping skin hidden. Pockets must not be exposed. Shorts must cover all of the back-side; fringe/fraying does not count toward length of short.
